Dear Parents, Staff and Children,

Staff Absences:

From time to time it is necessary to split grades due to teacher absences. Most absences can usually be covered by Casual Replacement Teachers (CRTs) but on some occasions there are not any CRTs available, due to demands from other schools. Class splitting, therefore becomes our only option. While we regret these interruptions to classes, we do make every effort to minimise the impact on the children's learning program.

Electronic Games

I would like you to remind your children that electronic games, toys, radios etc are not to be brought to school. I would like parents to reinforce this simple rule with their children. Things of this nature create a lot of interest among children often resulting in loss or damage to the equipment. Unfortunately all personal items brought to school are not covered by insurance.

School Uniforms:

I spoke to children at assembly on Monday about the need to be attentive with their school uniforms. In cold weather, a jacket or second windcheater can be worn for extra warmth but not instead of our uniform. If children need extra pieces of uniform they are able to ask for items from our second hand uniform supply. Please also remind children to search for any lost items at our "lost property area". Generally, all items which are named manage to be returned to their correct owners.

School Football:

Congratulations to our school team footy team on the successful progression to the Western Zone Finals which were conducted yesterday. Our team played very well in both games but were outpointed on both occasions. Thanks to Mr Field and parents of our players for your support during this exciting time.

Car Parking:

A reminder for parents who use the staff car park as a drop of zone each morning. Children walking through car parks are in danger and we ask that you reinforce "road safety" where you possibly can. Please support the school with his process.

Something I've noticed more recently in the playground is the number of children who run and play with shoelaces undone. We've had quite a few accidents caused by simply leaving shoelaces undone. Please remind all children of this simple preventative strategy.
